Hey there! Here's a game that's BIG on fun to go with these JUMBO cards!

Oh Really?!

Bluff your way to victory!

Goal

Be the first to get rid of all of your cards. Yep, you'll have to bluff to win!

How to Play

- Deal all 54 cards including Jokers to all players.
 Some players may have one more card than others.
 Jokers are wild in this game and can be any number!
- 2. Look at your cards. The player with the Ace of Hearts goes first. They place it face down on the table to start a discard pile, and announce the number of the card. Suits are not important. (Example - "One Ace!")
- 3. The next player must play a card for the next number in order. They place their card face down on the discard pile and announce its number. (Example - if the last card was a 5, the next player must play a 6, and so on...)
- ! Hint: You may also play more than one card at a time. It's a good way to get rid of more cards! Just announce them all as the same number (Example -"Three 8s!")

How to Play - continued

- 4. Here's the trick. Players will not always have the number they need. So, it's time to bluff. Choose any card(s) to play, but announce it as the correct number for the turn. Whether or not players believe you, well...that's up to you!
- ! Example if you need a 5 but don't have one, you can play any card but still announce "One 5!"
 Some players push their luck and try to bluff with more than one card like, "Two 5s!" even though it's really a 5 and a 3. Pretty sneaky, huh?
- 5. If anyone suspects a player of bluffing they can challenge them by calling out, "OH REALLY?" before the next card is played. Then the game stops while players check the last card played.
 - If a player was **BLUFFING** they pick up all the cards in the pile and put them in their hand.
 - If a player was **NOT BLUFFING** the accuser picks up all the cards in the pile.
- The game resumes with the next player playing the next number in order.
- 7. If a King is played, then numbering restarts with Aces.

Winning

The first player to get rid of all their cards wins!
